HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1057, L.D. 1546, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Unfair Trade Practices Act to Allow Consumers to Recover Damages"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the fiscal note and inserting in its place the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill allows consumers who have been injured by an illegal or unfair trade practice to seek from the business reimbursement for their damages.

The additional work load and administrative costs associated with an increase in the number of cases filed as a result of this provision will be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department.'
