'Sec.1. 20-A MRSA §6208 is enacted to read:

30 §6208. Two-year moratorium

32 The statewide educational assessment program is suspended for the 1991-92 and 1992-93 school years. No General Fund 34 expenditures may be made for the assessment program during those years.' 36

Further amend the bill in section 7 by striking out all of 38 the last 5 lines (page 2, lines 40 to 44 in L.D.) and inserting in their place the following:

'Provides for the
deappropriation of funds as a result of the 2-year
suspension of the educational assessment program.'

28	This amendment deletes the title, emergency preamble,
30	emergency clause and sections 1 to 6 of the bill and replaces them with a new title and language that suspends the assessment
32	program for school years 1991-92 and 1992-93. The original bill eliminates the assessment program. This amendment suspends the
34	program for the next biennium in an attempt to preserve other vital functions and services of various state departments and
36	agencies. It also adds a fiscal note.
