"Annual base compensation" 24 means a member's earnable gross compensation, as-adjusted-bybeard-rule-to-provide-an-equitable-and-stable-basis based upon 26 amounts reported by the member's employer on the member's previous year's federal wage and tax statement, that is used the 28 first day of each April for setting the amount of coverage for participants in the group life insurance program administered by 30 the board.' 32 Further amend the bill in section 2 in paragraph A in subparagraph (2) in the 3rd line (page 1, line 46 in L.D.) by 34 inserting at the beginning the following: 'of April' 36 Further amend the bill in section 6 in subsection 2 in paragraph A in the last line (page 3, line 48 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "years." the following: 'For the 38 purpose of determining the average amount of basic insurance in 40 force, there must be excluded from the amount of basic coverage in force during the last 3 years prior to retirement that portion 42 of basic coverage that exceeds the previous year's coverage by 10%.' 44 Further amend the bill in section 7 in paragraph A in

subparagraph (2) in the 3rd line (page 5, line 1 in L.D.) by

inserting at the beginning the following: 'of April'

2 Further amend the bill in section 11 in subsection 2 in paragraph A in the last line (page 7, line 5 in L.D.) by inserting after the following "retirement." the following: 'For the purpose of determining the average amount of basic insurance in force, there must be excluded from the amount of basic 6 coverage in force during the last 3 years prior to retirement that portion of basic coverage that exceeds the previous year's 8 coverage by 10%.' Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read 12

This amendment changes the original bill to adopt a simplified and more stable process for setting the amount of group life insurance coverage under the plan administered by the Maine State Retirement System. The retirement system would implement this process beginning in April of 1992. New employees would have their coverage based upon their estimated annual rate of gross earnings and those employees who during their first year of employment worked less than a full year would have their 2nd year based upon the annual equivalent of their partial year earnings.
