STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires the State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers to include engineers-in-training in the biennial roster and supplemental roster that they publish. Allocations from Other Special Revenue funds to the board of \$3,000 in fiscal year 1991-92 and \$1,000 in fiscal year 1992-93 are required for the additional printing costs. The bill also increases the cap for application and renewal fees. If the board adopted rules to increase fees to the maximum allowable, an additional \$131,000 could be generated annually.'

This amendment lowers the engineer's registration and reregistration fee limit in the bill from \$50 to \$40. The fee is currently \$25 for initial registration and \$15 for reregistration.

This amendment also adds an allocation and a fiscal note to the bill.
