COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " \mathcal{H} " to H.P. 1087, L.D. 1587, Bill, "An Act to Require Minimum Training Standards for Construction Flaggers"

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Amend the bill in that part designated "**§707.**" by striking out all of the first paragraph (page 1, lines 7 to 11 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'All privately employed flaggers at highway construction 22 sites on public ways must have training in controlling traffic at construction sites in a manner consistent with the standards set forth in the American National Standards Institute, Manual on 24 Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways. That training may consist of video instruction, instruction in a 26 classroom setting, distribution of informational handbooks or other educational materials or other training activities 28 determined appropriate by the employer. Municipalities are encouraged to provide the same training as is required for 30 privately employed flaggers to flaggers whom they employ.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment replaces the original bill. It requires that 98 privately employed flaggers at construction sites on public ways be provided training in techniques of directing traffic at 40 construction sites. The type and content of the training is left to the discretion of the employer but it must be consistent with 42 the standards for traffic control contained in the Federal Highway Administration Manual on Traffic Control Devices. 44 Municipalities are encouraged to provide the same training to flaggers whom they employ.
