12 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1089, L.D. 1589, Bill, "An 14 Act to Conform Chiropractic Licensing Laws to Other State Regulatory Board Laws"

Amend the bill in section 8 in that part designated "§552." 18 in the 2nd paragraph in the 5th line (page 5, line 6 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "not to exceed \$300" and inserting 20 in its place the following: 'of \$225'

Further amend the bill in section 10 in that part designated "<u>\$553-A.</u>" in subsection 3 by striking out all of the first paragraph (page 5, lines 39 to 41 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'3. Fees. Fees are established as follows:'

Further amend the bill in section 10 in that part designated 30 "<u>\$553-A.</u>" in paragraph C in the first line (page 5, line 47 in L.D.) and in paragraph D in the first line (page 5, line 49 in 32 L.D.) by striking out the following: "<u>\$300</u>" and inserting in its place the following: '<u>\$225</u>'

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 12 the following:

38 'Sec. 13. Allocation. The following funds are allocated from Other Special Revenue to carry out the purposes of this Act.

This bill increases the fees of the Board of Chiropractic Examination and Registration and requires an allocation from Other Special Revenue of \$3,000 in fiscal year 1991-92 to cover the costs associated with rulemaking. Additional dedicated revenues generated through the fee increases, estimated to be \$5,000 annually, will enable the Board of Chiropractic Examination and Registration to meet its projected expenditures for the next biennium.

30 This bill also establishes a Class E crime. The additional work load and administrative costs associated with a minimal 32 number of new cases filed in District Court as a result of the violation will be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the 34 Judicial Department.

36 Sentences imposed for a Class E offense must be served in a county jail facility. The projected cost to a county for each 38 person sentenced under the new Class E crime is approximately \$3,820 and is based upon an average length of stay of 67 days.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

The original bill raised the limit for licensing of 6 chiropractors from \$100 annually to \$300 biennially. This amendment removes the concept of a limit and sets the fee at \$225 8 biennially.

50 The amendment also adds an allocation and a fiscal note to the bill.
