COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1100, L.D. 1599, "Resolve, to Instruct the Department of Education to Eliminate the School System "Report Card" Program"

Amend the resolve by striking out all of the emergency preamble (page 1, lines 1 to 17 in L.D.).

Further amend the resolve in the first resolve paragraph by inserting at the beginning of the first line (page 1, line 19 in L.D.) the following: 'Sec. 1.' and in the last line (page 1, line 22 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "program." and inserting in its place the following: 'program; and be it further

Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the emergency clause the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. Resolved: That the following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this resolve.

Deappropriates funds no longer needed due to the elimination of the school report card system.'

2 Further amend the resolve by striking out all of the

16 This resolve eliminates the Department of Education's school  
report card system, resulting in savings from reduced printing  
18 and distribution costs of \$15,000 annually, beginning in fiscal  
year 1991-92. These amounts are deappropriated from the  
20 department's General Fund budget, based on the Governor's  
adjusted current services budget proposal. Actual savings will  
22 depend on the final enacted version of the current services  
budget.'

26 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

28 This amendment strikes out the emergency preamble and  
30 emergency clause and adds an appropriation and fiscal note to the  
resolve.
