An Act Regarding the Issuance of Special Plates for Rescue Unit Workers and Providers of Emergency Medical Services.



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	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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	STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill creates a special license plate for rescue unit workers and emergency medical services' personnel. It also provides for a \$50 forfeiture for failure by inactive rescue workers to return recalled license plates to the Secretary of State.

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
