SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1105, L.D. 1604, "Resolve, to Create a Commission to Study the Need for a Technical College in York County"

Amend the amendment by striking out everything after the title and inserting in its place the following:

'Amend the resolve by striking out everything after the emergency preamble and before the emergency clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. Duties. Resolved: That the Board of Trustees of the Maine Technical College System shall study the need for a technical college in York County. In conducting the study the trustees shall:

1. Examine postsecondary vocational and technical education currently available in York County;
2. Assess the current and future demand of area citizens for postsecondary vocational and technical education in York County;
3. Assess the current and future work force needs of the State's employers;
4. Assess the needs of people who have been traditionally underserved by the Maine Technical College System, including women, minorities and persons with disabilities;

2 5. Make recommendations to provide postsecondary vocational
and technical education in York County that adequately meets the
4 needs of area citizens and the State's employers; and

6 6. Make recommendations, if appropriate, to establish a
York County Technical College of the Maine Technical College
8 System; and be it further

10 **Sec. 2. Report. Resolved:** That the Board of Trustees of the
Maine Technical College System shall submit its report, together
12 with any necessary implementing legislation, to the Second
Regular Session of the 115th Legislature no later than November
14 1, 1991.'

16 Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the
statement of fact the following:


STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment strikes all provisions of the resolve that
30 create a commission to study the need for a technical college in
York County and replaces these provisions with a directive to the
32 Board of Trustees of the Maine Technical College System to
conduct a similar study. The amendment also adds a fiscal note
34 to the resolve.
