An allocation of Other 36 Special Revenue funds is required by the Legislature in the amount of \$500 in fiscal year 1991-92 for printing and other 38 miscellaneous commission expenses. Authorization is given to seek outside revenue sources. If no outside funding is 40 available, the commission may not incur expenditures. In particular, General Fund expenditures are prohibited.' 42 STATEMENT OF FACT 44 This amendment changes the composition of the Commission to 46 Study the Need for a Technical College in York County by reducing the number of Senators from 2 to one and by reducing the number 48 of members from the House of Representatives from 2 to one. It 50 stipulates that 2 tradespeople will be appointed to the submitted Maine commission, one from nominations by the Tradeswomen's Network and one from nominations submitted by the 52 Maine American Federation of Labor - Congress of Industrial

2 The amendment adds a duty requiring the commission to assess the needs of people who have been traditionally underserved, 4 including women, minorities and persons with disabilities. It adds York County as a possible commission meeting site and makes other minor changes to the commission's powers.

8 The amendment deletes the request for staff assistance, reimbursement for commission members and the appropriation. It adds a provision prohibiting expenditures from the General Fund 10 and permits the Legislative Council to administer outside funds acquired for the conduct of the study. 12 

14 The amendment also adds an allocation and a fiscal note to the resolve.
