Further amend the bill in section 2 in the 2nd and 3rd lines (page 1, lines 25 and 26 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "only at one main entrance" and inserting in its place the following: 'at all entrances'

By requiring a sign at only one main entrance, the original bill modifies the current law that requires a warning sign at each booth at a gun show.
