	repeals additional sunset provisions. The sunset on the potato
6	variety labeling program is repealed. The sunset on laws enacted
	to reduce the theft of blueberries is repealed. Both have sunset
8	dates of July 1, 1991.

10 The amendment also repeals the requirement that the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources institute an educational program under the country of origin labeling laws, deletes the appropriation and replaces the fiscal note.
