HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 614,
L.D. 1618, Bill, "An Act to Provide Due Process To Participants
in the Driver Education Evaluation Program"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the 6th indented
paragraph (page 1, lines 38 to 40 in amendment) and inserting in
its place the following:

'Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 1.'

Further amend the amendment by inserting after the emergency
clause the following:

'Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read
consecutively.'

Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of
fact the following:'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment deletes the provision of the bill allowing
the Department of Human Services to consider payment of all
counseling fees in determining whether a Driver Education
Evaluation Program client has completed treatment. This
amendment eliminates the possibility that the State will be used
as a collection agency for treatment providers by withholding the
driver's license until counseling fees are paid.
