An Act Concerning Exemption from Property Tax of Wetlands.



be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:	
Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §656, sub-§1, ¶I, as enacted by PL 1983, 555, §3, is amended to read:	С
I. Mining property as provided in section 2854+; and	
Sec. 2. 36 MRSA §656, sub-§1, ¶J is enacted to read:	

10 Any parcel of land with an area greater than one acre when that parcel is recognized and classified as wetland by 12 any federal, state or local agency. For purposes of this section, "wetland" means coastal wetlands, as defined in 14 Title 38, section 482, subsection 2-E, and freshwater wetlands, which are freshwater swamps, marshes, bogs and 16 similar areas that are characterized predominantly by wetland vegetation and are not considered part of a great 18 pond, coastal wetland, river, stream or brook. Any parcel exempted from taxation under this section may not be used 20 when calculating the minimum number of acres needed for purposes of subdivision.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill exempts from property taxation any parcel of land greater than one acre in area that is classified as wetland.
