An Act to Require State Employees to Reimburse the State for
Frequent-flier Awards.



2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 Sec. 1. 3 MRSA §2-B is enacted to read:

6 §2-B. Frequent-flier awards

8 A member of the Senate or House of Representatives who earns
10 a frequent-flier award on travel paid for by the State must
12 reimburse the State at the rate of 2¢ per mile for use of the
14 frequent-flier awards on travel not required by the State.

16 Sec. 2. 5 MRSA §13-A is enacted to read:

18 §13-A. Frequent-flier awards

20 A state employee who earns a frequent-flier award on travel
22 paid for by the State must reimburse the State at the rate of 2¢
24 per mile for use of the frequent-flier awards on travel not
26 required by the State. For the purposes of this section,
28 "employee" means an employee in the unclassified or classified
30 services, as defined in chapters 71 and 372.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires state employees and members of the Legislature to reimburse the State at the rate of 2¢ per mile for personal use of frequent-flier awards earned on travel funded by the State.
