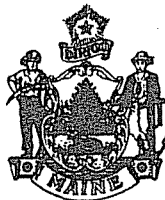

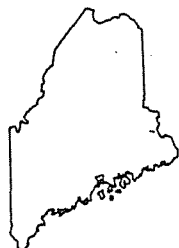

They Apply to the Banking Industry.**

(AFTER DEADLINE)



2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 9-B MRSA §244, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 500, §1, is**
repealed.

6 **Sec. 2. 10 MRSA §1102-A, last ¶, as enacted by PL 1983, c. 340,**
8 **§1, is repealed.**

10 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

12 **This bill repeals the consumer and antitrust exemptions that**
14 **presently apply to the banking industry.**
