IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

An Act to Ensure Impartiality in Local Planning and Appeals Boards.

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## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

30-A MRSA §2605, sub-§8 is enacted to read:

8. Planning board or board of appeals members. Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, a person who is a licensed real estate broker in this State, a land use developer or consultant, a housing or building contractor or any person in their employ may not be appointed to or serve on a municipal planning board or board of appeals.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill prohibits licensed real estate brokers, land use developers and consultants and housing or building contractors from serving on municipal planning boards or boards of appeals in order to ensure the impartiality of board members in acting on requests for land use or building permits and variances.

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
