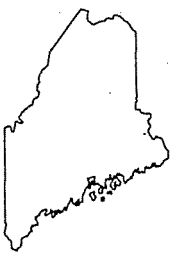

**An Act to Prohibit Emission of Unreasonable Noise from Motor
Vehicles.**



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2
4 29 MRSA §1362, as amended by PL 1989, c. 32, §2, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

6 A vehicle or any auxiliary device, including, but not
8 limited to, a radio or loudspeaker in or on a vehicle, may not be
10 operated in a manner that allows a harsh, objectionable or
12 unreasonable noise to emanate from the vehicle. This paragraph
14 does not apply to devices used to generate political messages or
16 speeches.

14 STATEMENT OF FACT

16 This bill prohibits the operation of a radio, loudspeaker or
18 other auxiliary device on or in a vehicle in a manner that causes annoyingly loud noises. The restriction does not apply to political speech.
