An Act Concerning the State's Escrow Accounts.



	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §§135-A and 203-A are enacted to read:

б	§135-A. Establishment of other special revenue accounts
8	All departments and agencies of State Government, in working with the Treasurer of State, are prohibited from establishing
Ü	trust funds, escrow accounts or any other account other than a
10	other special revenue account unless there is a compelling documented reason to do otherwise.
12	§203-A. Accounts established due to court orders or other
14	settlements
16	Unless specifically ordered by the court to do otherwise the Attorney General shall work with the Treasure of State to
18	deposit any revenue or money received as a result of any court order, court settlement or other agreement into an other special
20	revenue account of the State and all interest must be credited to the General Fund.

24	Sec. 2. Retroactivity. This Act applies retroactively to January 1, 1980.

28	STATEMENT OF FACT
30	This bill prohibits the use of escrow accounts by the Department of the Attorney General when court orders of
32	settlements provide resources to State Government unless the court specifically orders otherwise. Also, this bill directs al
34	departments and agencies to place new or existing resources in other special revenue accounts unless there is a compelling
36	reason to do otherwise.
