HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1142, L.D. 1667, Bill, "An Act to Regulate Sales of Malt Liquor in Kegs"

Amend the amendment in that part designated "\$714." in subsection 5 in the first line (page 2, line 35 in amendment) by inserting after the word "removal" the following: 'or defacing'

Further amend the amendment in that part designated "\$714." in subsection 5 by striking out all of the last underlined sentence (page 2, lines 39 to 43 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following: 'If a person who purchased a properly tagged keg returns the keg without a tag or with a defaced tag, that person is presumed to have removed or defaced the tag.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The amendment clarifies the presumption that a person who returns a defaced or tagless keg is presumed to have removed or defaced the tag if that person was also the purchaser of the keg.
