HOUSE AMENDMENT "H" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1142, L.D. 1667, Bill, "An Act to Regulate Sales of Malt Liquor in Kegs"

Amend the amendment in that part designated "<u>§714.</u>" in 18 subsection 5 in the first line (page 2, line 35 in amendment) by inserting after the word "<u>removal</u>" the following: '<u>or defacing</u>'

Further amend the amendment in that part designated "<u>§714.</u>" 22 in subsection 5 by striking out all of the last underlined sentence (page 2, lines 39 to 43 in amendment) and inserting in 24 its place the following: '<u>If a person who purchased a properly</u> tagged keg returns the keg without a tag or with a defaced tag, 26 that person is presumed to have removed or defaced the tag.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

32 The amendment clarifies the presumption that a person who returns a defaced or tagless keg is presumed to have removed or 34 defaced the tag if that person was also the purchaser of the keg.
