Be	it	enacted	by	the	Peor	le of	the	State	of	Maine	as	follows:

28-A MRSA §402, sub-§6, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 45, Pt. A, §4, is amended to read:

6. Commission not to close state stores. The commission shall may not close any state liquor store unless-it-netifies-the joint-standing-committee-of-the-Legislature-have-jurisdiction over-legal-affairs at-least-60-days-before-the-effective-date-of the-closing. The-legislative-committee-may-hold-a-public-hearing on-the-proposed-closing-and-advise-the-commission-of-its-findings.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill prohibits the State Liquor Commission from closing state liquor stores. If the commission intends to close a store, it would be required to submit legislation to exempt the closure from the operation of this law. This process allows the Legislature to have a stronger voice in the decision to close stores than under current law. Current law only permits the Legislature to advise the commission on whether to close a state liquor store.
