IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

An Act to Provide for the 1991 and 1992 Allocations of the State Ceiling on Private Activity Bonds.

(AFTER DEADLINE)

(EMERGENCY)

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Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

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Whereas, the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 10, section 363 and Public Law 1989, chapter 812 make a partial allocation of the state ceiling on private activity bonds to some issuers for calendar year 1991, but leave a portion of the state ceiling unallocated and do not provide sufficient allocations for certain types of private activity bonds that may require an allocation prior to the effective date of this Act if not enacted on an emergency basis; and

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Whereas, if these bond issues must be delayed due to lack of available state ceiling, the rates and terms under which these bonds may be issued may be adversely affected, resulting in increased costs to beneficiaries or even unavailability of financing for certain projects; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. Allocation to the Treasurer of State. Ten million dollars 28 of the state ceiling for calendar year 1991 previously allocated to the Treasurer of State remains allocated to the Treasurer of 30 Ten million dollars of the state ceiling for calendar year 1992 is allocated to the Treasurer of State to be used in 32 accordance with the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 10, section 363, subsection 5. 34

Sec. 2. Allocation to the Finance Authority of Maine. \$25,000,000 in state ceiling for calendar year 1991 previously allocated to the Finance Authority of Maine, plus an additional \$55,000,000, is allocated to the Finance Authority of Maine to be used or reallocated in accordance with the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 10, section 363, subsection 6. Twenty-five million dollars of the state ceiling for calendar year 1992 is allocated to the Finance Authority of Maine to be used or reallocated in accordance with Title 10, section 363, subsection

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Sec. 3. Allocation to the Maine Municipal Bond Bank. \$10,000,000 of the state ceiling previously allocated to the Maine Municipal Bond Bank for calendar year 1991 remains allocated to the Maine Municipal Bond Bank to be used or reallocated accordance in with

the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 10, section 363, subsection 7. 2 Ten million dollars of the state ceiling for calendar year 1992 is allocated to the Maine Municipal Bond Bank to be used or 4 reallocated in accordance with Title 10, section 363, subsection б Sec. 4. Allocation to the Maine Educational Loan Authority. None 8 of the state ceiling for calendar year 1991 is allocated to the Maine Educational Loan Authority. None of the state ceiling for 10 calendar year 1992 is allocated to the Maine Educational Loan Authority. 12 Sec. 5. Allocation to the Maine State Housing Authority. 14 Twenty-five million dollars of the state ceiling for calendar year 1991 previously allocated to the Maine State Housing 16 Authority remains allocated to the Maine State Housing Authority to be used or reallocated in accordance with the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 10, section 363, subsection 4. 18 Twenty-five million dollars of the state ceiling for calendar year 1992 is 20 allocated to the Maine State Housing Authority for the same uses. 22 Sec. 6. Allocation to the Maine Educational Loan Marketing Corporation. Twenty-five million dollars of the state ceiling 24 calendar year 1991 previously allocated to the Maine Educational Loan Marketing Corporation remains allocated to the 26 Maine Educational Loan Marketing Corporation to be used or reallocated in accordance with the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 28 10, section 363, subsection 8. Twenty-five million dollars of the state ceiling for calendar year 1992 is allocated to the Maine Educational Loan Marketing Corporation to be used or 30 reallocated in accordance with the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 32 10, section 363, subsection 8.

Sec. 7. Unallocated state ceiling. Fifty-five million dollars of the state ceiling for calendar year 1992 is unallocated and must be reserved for future allocation in accordance with applicable laws.

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Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill establishes the allocations of state ceiling for calendar years 1991 and 1992.
