An Act to Review the Kennebec County Budget Committee.

(EMERGENCY)

2 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not
become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
as emergencies; and

6 Whereas, without emergency action by the Legislature, the
law authorizing the Kennebec County Budget Committee to continue
operating will be repealed on March 1, 1991; and

10 Whereas, legislative action is immediately necessary in
order to ensure the continuation of the Kennebec County Budget
Committee beyond March 1, 1991; and

14 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
16 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
safety; now, therefore,

18 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

20 **30-A MRSA §867**, as enacted by PL 1989, c. 473, is repealed.

22 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the
24 preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.

28 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

30 This bill ensures continuance of the Kennebec County Budget
Committee by repealing the sunset provision.
