32	Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the fiscal note and inserting in its place the following:
34	'FISCAL NOTE
36	This bill establishes the Higher Education Loan Program
38	within the Finance Authority of Maine. Funds are not provided to capitalize this program.
40	This bill also reduces the residency requirements in the
42	Blaine House Scholars and Financial Assistance Program, which will allow an increased number of eligible applicants for that
44	program. General Fund appropriations to the Finance Authority of Maine will be required in order to serve both those currently
46	served as well as those newly eligible for scholarships.

The costs associated with administering the new loan program and for expanded responsibilities within the Blaine House Scholars and Financial Assistance Program will be absorbed within existing resources of the Finance Authority of Maine.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies that any future bond funds and principal repayments may only be used for student loans and may not be used to fund administrative costs of the Finance Authority of Maine. The amendment removes the provision authorizing issuance of bonds to finance the Higher Education Loan Program.
