COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1155, L.D. 1696, Bill, "An Act Concerning the Unlawful Prohibition of Legal Activities as a Condition of Employment"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill provides that employers may not discriminate against employees who use tobacco products outside the course of employment. While the Department of Labor will have no direct enforcement responsibilities, the number of telephone inquiries and complaints will increase. This additional work load can be handled by the Bureau of Labor Standards utilizing existing budgeted staff and resources.'

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
