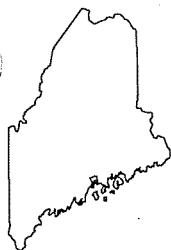

**An Act to Provide a Juvenile Offender with a Continuum of Services
through the Department of Human Services.**



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2
4 22 MRSA §4042 is enacted to read:

6 **§4042. Continued services**

8 Except as preempted by federal law or regulation, if custody
10 of a child is transferred from the department to the child's
12 parent, the department shall provide the same level of services
14 to a child living in the child's home when custody is to the
16 child's parent as the department would provide if the department
18 had custody of the child.

22 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

24 This bill requires that if custody of a child is transferred
26 from the Department of Human Services to the parent, the
28 department must continue to provide the same level of services as
30 it would if the child were still in the department's custody.
