24	A veterinarian or a registered animal technician may use or administer biosynthetic bovine somatotropin, known as BST, for
26	research purposes only. It is unlawful for a person who is not a veterinarian or a registered animal technician under the
28	supervision of a veterinarian to use or administer BST. In addition to other penalties provided by law, if BST is present on
30	a dairy farm, except in possession or control of a veterinarian or a registered animal technician using or administering BST for
32	research purposes, the commissioner shall suspend the farm's operating permit issued under section 2902-A. The suspension may
34 ·	be for a period of up to 30 days and must be in accordance with Title 5, section 10004.

38	For the purposes of this section, "research" means a class of activities designed to develop or contribute to generalizable
	knowledge or the accumulation of data that can be corroborated by
40	accepted scientific observation and inferences. A veterinarian
42	using or administering BST for research purposes subsequent to commercial approval of BST by the federal Food and Drug Administration, pursuant to 21 Code of Federal Regulations, Part

514, must submit to the department prior written notice identifying the owner and location of the animals to which BST will be administered, the explicit objectives of the research and

2	objectives. Such notices are public records within the meaning
	of Title 1, section 402, subsection 3. The veterinarian shall

6	animals to which BST is administered during the research.

12	STATEMENT OF FACT
14	This amendment adds a definition of research to the laws concerning biosynthetic bovine somatotropin, or BST. The
16	amendment requires a veterinarian administering BST for research
	purposes to submit documentation on the research to the
18	Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources and also extends the repeal date to March 1, 1993.
