30	penalties provided by law, if BST is present on a dairy farm, except in possession or control of a veterinarian or a registered
32	animal technician under the supervision of a veterinarian using or administering BST for research purposes, the commissioner
34	shall suspend the farm's operating permit issued under section 2902-A. The suspension may be for a period of up to 30 days and
