Page 1-LR0674(1) L.D.1710 determination that the employee does not gualify as a bone marrow donor, the paid leave of absence granted to the employee prior to that medical determination is not forfeited.

2. No employer sanctions. An employer may not retaliate against an employee for requesting or obtaining a leave of absence as provided by this section.

3. Relationship to other leave. This section does not prevent an employer from providing leave for bone marrow donations in addition to leave allowed under this section. This section does not affect an employee's rights with respect to any other employment benefit.

<u>§1659. Bone marrow donor drive</u>

The commissioner shall conduct a bone marrow donor drive to encourage state employees to volunteer to be potential bone marrow donors. This drive must include educational materials and presentations that explain the need for bone marrow donors and the procedures for becoming registered as a potential bone marrow donor. The Director of Employee Relations within the Department of Administration shall provide assistance as needed to organize and conduct the drive. The bone marrow donor drive must be completed by June 30, 1992.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
