18	Amend the bill in the question in the last line (page 1, line 20 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "other" the following: 'transportation'

22	Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:
24	'FISCAL NOTE
26	The estimated cost of sending this resolution out to referendum will vary according to the total number of referenda.
28	The estimated cost to the Secretary of State if one to 6 referenda are enacted is \$95,000. Each additional referendum
30	costs an additional \$6,500.
32	If approved by the voters, this resolution would allow Highway Fund revenues to be used for other than highway
.34	purposes. Highway Fund revenues would still be dedicated by statute.'

38	STATEMENT OF FACT
40	The bill repeals the provision in the Constitution that dedicates highway funds solely to highway and bridge expenditures
42	and permits those funds to be spent for other purposes. This amendment specifies that the funds can be spent only on other
44	transportation purposes and adds a fiscal note to the bill.
