Sec. 1. Department of Education and Bureau of Insurance directed to develop proposal to allow schools in the State to self-insure. Resolved: That the Department of Education and the Bureau of Insurance shall develop a proposal to allow elementary and secondary schools in the State to self-insure for property, fire and theft. The proposal must provide for the establishment of a reserve fund to indemnify the State for losses arising from self-insurance; and be it further

Sec. 2. Submission date established. Resolved: That the Department of Education and the Bureau of Insurance shall submit the proposal together with the necessary implementing legislation to the Joint Standing Committee on Education no later than November 1, 1992.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill directs the Department of Education and the Bureau of Insurance to prepare a proposal to allow elementary and secondary schools in Maine to self-insure for property, fire and theft.
