**An Act Requiring Notice by the Secretary of State before Suspension or
Expiration of a Motor Vehicle Registration.**



2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **29 MRSA §104-A is enacted to read:**

6 **§104-A. Notice of suspension or expiration**

8 The Secretary of State shall provide written notice at least
10 7 days before suspension or expiration of a motor vehicle
12 registration. The notice must be sent by regular mail, allowing
14 at least 3 days, exclusive of Sundays, for delivery to the last
16 known address of the registrant. For purposes of this section,
18 the "last known address of the registrant" means the address
20 given by the registrant at the initial registration of the motor
22 vehicle unless the Secretary of State has received actual written
notice of a change of address of the registrant.

18 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

20 This bill requires the Secretary of State to provide written
22 notice to registrants at least 7 days before suspension or
expiration of their motor vehicle registrations.
