An Act Requiring Notice by the Secretary of State before Suspension or Expiration of a Motor Vehicle Registration.



		Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2		29 MRSA §104-A is enacted to read:

		§104-A. Notice of suspension or expiration

		The Secretary of State shall provide written notice at least
8		7 days before suspension or expiration of a motor vehicle
		registration. The notice must be sent by regular mail, allowing
10		at least 3 days, exclusive of Sundays, for delivery to the last
		known address of the registrant. For purposes of this section,
12		the "last known address of the registrant" means the address
		given by the registrant at the initial registration of the motor
14		vehicle unless the Secretary of State has received actual written
		notice of a change of address of the registrant.
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18		STATEMENT OF FACT
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20		This bill requires the Secretary of State to provide written
		notice to registrants at least 7 days before suspension or
22		expiration of their motor vehicle registrations.
