This bill establishes new license fee caps for the Maine State Board for Licensure of Architects and Landscape Architects and increases the membership of the board by one member. Allocations of Other Special Revenue funds of \$6,545 in fiscal
year 1991-92 and \$1,020 in fiscal year 1992-93 are required by the board for the per diem and expenses of the new member and the per diem and expenses of board members and other expenses related
to rulemaking. The additional dedicated revenues generated,
estimated to be \$50,000 annually, will enable the Maine State Board for Licensure of Architects and Landscape Architects to meet its projected expenditures for the next biennium.'
STATEMENT OF FACT
This amendment does the following.
1. It adds a 2nd public member to the Maine State Board for Licensure of Architects and Landscape Architects.
2. It allows the use of the title "architectural designer."
3. It allows the practice of landscape architecture without
a license. It removes the exempted practices that are no longer necessary with the elimination of the prohibition on practicing the profession.
4. It grants to transportation landscape architects employed by the government an exemption to the requirement that a license is needed to use the title "landscape architect."
