SENATE AMENDMENT " B " to H.P. 1190, L.D. 1743, Bill, "An Act to Provide for Deferrals of Unfunded State Mandates for Municipalities Experiencing Financial Hardships"

Amend the bill in subsection 2 in the last line (page 1, line 30 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "mandate." the following: 'This subsection does not apply to any mandate for which a waiver may be sought pursuant to Title 20-A, section 2-A.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies that the procedure for waivers of education mandates must be in accordance with provisions enacted by Public Law 1991, chapter 429.
