HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1193, L.D. 1746, Bill, "An Act to Establish a Budget Process for Sagadahoc County"

Amend the amendment in that part designated "§883." in subsection 1 in the first line (page 1, line 43 in amendment) by striking out the following: "~~membership; election.~~" and inserting in its place the following: 'membership.'

Further amend the amendment in that part designated "§883." in subsection 1 by striking out paragraphs A to D (page 2, lines 1 to 49 in amendment) and inserting in their place the following:

'A. The budget advisory committee consists of 9 members: two municipal officers from each of the 3 county commissioner districts and one representative of the general public from each of the 3 county commissioner districts. Budget advisory committee members serve 3-year terms, except for the initial members whose terms are provided in subsection 2, paragraph B. If a budget advisory committee member who is elected as a municipal officer ceases to be a municipal officer during the term of membership, that committee member shall vacate membership.

(1) If a budget advisory committee member who is elected as a municipal officer vacates, resigns or is unable to complete the term of office to which that member was elected, the next district caucus shall elect a municipal officer to serve for the remainder of the unexpired term.

(2) If a budget advisory committee member who is a representative of the general public resigns or is unable to complete the term of office to which that member was elected, the next district caucus shall elect a representative of the general public to serve for the remainder of the unexpired term.

2 B. The budget advisory committee shall select annually one
3 of its members to chair the committee.

5 2. Election. The election of the budget advisory committee
6 members is as follows:

7 A. Before September 15th of every year, the county
8 commissioners shall notify all municipal officers in the
9 county to caucus by county commissioner districts at a
10 specified date, time and place for the purpose of electing
11 the membership of the county budget advisory committee.
12 Whenever a public member of the budget advisory committee
13 will be elected, the county commissioners must issue a
14 public notice of that fact that includes the date, time and
15 place of the caucus. The county commissioner shall serve as
16 nonvoting moderator for that commissioner's district
17 caucus. Nominations must be received from the floor. The
18 nominee receiving the most votes is approved as a budget
19 advisory committee member and serves a term of 3 years,
20 except as provided in paragraph B.

21 B. In 1991, each caucus shall elect 3 members whose terms
22 are as follows.

23 (1) One of the members who is a municipal officer
24 shall serve an initial term of one year.

25 (2) One of the members who is a municipal officer
26 shall serve an initial term of 2 years.

27 (3) The member who is a representative of the general
28 public shall serve an initial term of 3 years.'

32 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

33 This amendment retains all of the substantive provisions of
34 the committee amendment but reorganizes the statutory units so
35 that the law may be better understood and implemented.
