12	In the original bill, the Sagadahoc County Budget Advisory Committee was comprised of elected municipal officials only.
14	This amendment changes the composition of the committee to include 6 elected municipal officials and 3 representatives of
16	the general public. This amendment also adds an emergency preamble, emergency clause and a sunset provision to the bill.
