8 .	YORK COUNTY BUDGET COMMITTEE
10	§891. Definitions
12	As used in this article, unless the context otherwise indicates, the following terms have the following meanings.
14	1. County commissioners. "County commissioners" means the elected county commissioners of York County.
16	2. Municipal officers. "Municipal officers" means the
18	elected mayor, aldermen, councillors or selectmen.
20	§892. York County Budget Committee
22	In York County there is established the York County Budget Committee to carry out the purposes of this article.
24	1. Membership. The county budget committee consists of 9
26	members, 3 members from each commissioner district selected at
28	least 90 days before the end of the fiscal year as provided for in this section. Of the 3 members from each commissioner district, 2 must be municipal officers and one must be a
30	representative of the general public. All 3 members are appointed by the county commissioners.
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34	2. Duties. It is the responsibility of the county budget committee to review the itemized budget estimates prepared by the county commissioners and make recommendations concerning the
36	proposed budget.
38	3. Terms. The term of office is as follows.
40	A. One of the members who is a municipal officer has an initial term of one year.
42	P One of the members who is a municipal officer has an
44	B. One of the members who is a municipal officer has an initial term of 2 years.
46	C. The member who is a representative of the general public has an initial term of 3 years.
48	The terms of the respective members increase by one year at the
50	time of reappointment, except the 3-year term, which becomes a one-year term:
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4. Vacancy. A vacancy occurring on the county budget

2 committee is filled in the same manner as the original appointment for the balance of the unexpired term. The person appointed to fill the vacant position must have the same qualifications as the person vacating the position.

6 5. Compensation. Members serve without compensation.

8 §893. County budget committee organization

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The county budget committee shall conduct its meetings in

The county budget committee shall conduct its meetings in public at the county courthouse. The county commissioners shall direct the county clerk to call an organizational meeting of the county budget committee within 15 days after the budget has been prepared by the county commissioners. The county commissioners shall provide the county budget committee with necessary clerical assistance, office expenses and suitable meeting space, as well as access to county files and information. The county budget committee shall select its own chair, vice-chair and secretary. The county budget committee shall adopt written rules or procedures and bylaws.

\$894. Budget procedures

1. Proposed budget. The county commissioners shall submit itemized budget estimates, as described in sections 701,702 and 7503, to the county budget committee no later than 90 days before the end of the county's fiscal year.

- 2. Budget review process. The county budget committee shall review the itemized budget estimates prepared by the county commissioners together with any supplementary material prepared by the head of each county department or provided by any independent board, institution or governmental agency. The county budget committee may make recommendations concerning any increase, decrease, alteration or revision to the proposed budget. These activities must be completed before November 1st.
- 3. Meeting with legislative delegation. Before November 15th, the county commissioners shall meet with the county legislative delegation to review and finalize estimates for the year.
- 4. Public hearing. The county commissioners shall hold a public hearing in the county on the proposed budget prior to December 1st and before the final adoption of the budget. Notice of the hearing must be given at least 10 days before the hearing in all newspapers of general circulation in the county. Written notice and a copy of the proposed budget must be sent by mail or delivered in person to the clerk of each municipality in the county and to the members of the county budget committee. 	5. Adoption of budget. After the public hearing is
	completed, the county commissioners may further increase,
	decrease, alter and revise the proposed budget provided that the
	county commissioners:
	A. Enter into their minutes and submit to the county budget
	committee a statement of their bases for any rejection of
	any recommendation of the county budget committee; and
	B. Hold a public meeting prior to December 7th with the
	county budget committee to discuss any rejections.

	The proposed budget must be finally adopted by a majority vote of
	the county commissioners at a duly called meeting not later than
	December 15th.
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	6. Interim approval by legislative delegation. Before
	submitting the proposed budget to the Legislature under
	subsection 7, the county commissioners shall submit the proposed
	budget to the legislative delegation. The legislative delegation
	shall render a decision by January 1st. Failure to do so is
	considered approval of the budget as submitted. If the
	legislative delegation disapproves of the proposed budget, the
	county commissioners shall submit, within 15 calendar days, new
	proposals in accordance with subsection 1 and the provisions of
	this section must be followed until a proposed budget is approved
	by the legislative delegation.
	7. Final budget approval. Before January 1st of the fiscal
	year for which the budget is prepared, the county commissioners
	shall submit the proposed budget to the Legislature. The
	Legislature shall approve, disapprove or amend the proposed
	budget as submitted.
	8. Assessment of taxes. The budget as approved by the
	Legislature is the final authorization for the assessment of
	county taxes. The budget must be sent to the county
	commissioners and the county tax authorized must be apportioned
	and collected in accordance with section 706.
	9. Interim budget. Until a budget is finally adopted, the
	county shall operate on an interim budget, which may not exceed
	the previous year's budget.
	10. Transfer of funds. The county commissioners may
	transfer funds as provided in section 922.
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	§895. Budget amendments

The budget governs the expenditures of the county during the fiscal year. Expenses may not be incurred in excess of those 2 shown in the budget, but the budget may be from time to time 4 revised by the preparation by the county commissioners of a proposed amended budget. This proposed amended budget must be submitted to the county budget committee for review. Any б recommendations by the county budget committee must be submitted 8 within 10 calendar days. After receiving the recommendation of the county budget committee, the county commissioners shall 10 forward the proposed amended budget to the legislative delegation for approval. The legislative delegation has 10 calendar days to 12 render a decision on the proposed amended budget. Failure of the legislative delegation to render a decision within the specified 14 time is considered an approval of the proposed amended budget. If the legislative delegation disapproves of the proposed amended 16 budget, the procedure in section 894, subsection 6, must be followed. The county commissioners shall submit the proposed 18 amended budget to the Legislature for approval, disapproval or amendment. If approved, the Legislature shall transmit a report 20 of approval of the revised budget to the State Auditor within 15 days of that approval.

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§896. Filing of budget

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A copy of the budget and subsequent amendments must be filed, on forms approved by the Department of Audit, with the State Auditor, who shall retain them for 3 years.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill authorizes changes in the budget process in York County.
