HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1217, L.D. 1775, Bill, "An Act to Prescribe the Duties and Liabilities of Ice-skating Rink Operators and Persons Who Use Ice-skating Rinks"

Amend the bill in that part designated "\$622." in subsection 2 in the first line (page 1, line 22 in L.D.) by inserting before the following: "person" the following: 'private' and in the 3rd line (page 1, line 24 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "may" and inserting in its place the following: 'does not'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment removes political subdivisions of the State from the definition of operator in order that they may retain the protections afforded by the Maine Tort Claims Act.
