Each skater shall maintain control of the skater's speed and course at all times when skating and be alert and observant as to avoid other skaters, spectators and objects. A skater attempting to overtake other skaters shall do so in a manner that avoids collision with structures and other skaters in that skater's field of vision.

Insofar as the dangers inherent in ice-skating are obvious,12by participating in ice-skating, a person accepts those dangers.<br/>Those dangers include, but are not limited to, injuries that14result from collisions with other skaters, injuries that result<br/>from falls and injuries that involve objects or artificial16structures properly within the intended travel of the skater that<br/>are not otherwise attributable to a breach of the operator's18common law duties.

20 §626. Violation; liability

22 <u>A skater or operator who violates this chapter is liable to</u> an injured person in a civil action for damages resulting from 24 <u>the violation</u>.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill prescribes the duties and liabilities of 30 ice-skating rink operators and persons who use ice-skating rinks. The bill also provides for the acceptance of certain 32 risks by persons who utilize ice-skating rinks.
