Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the
2 Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after
adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, in 1987 a recodification of the Maine Revised
6 Statutes, Title 29, was authorized by Resolve 1987, chapter 33;
and

Whereas, pursuant to Resolve 1989, chapter 69, a report was
10 to be presented by January 1, 1991 with the proposed
recodification; and

Whereas, in light of the State's fiscal condition the
14 Legislature desires to defer consideration of this recodification
until next session to save associated expenditures in this fiscal
16 year; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
20 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
22 safety; now, therefore, be it

Sec. 1. Resolve 1987, c. 33, amended. Resolved: That Resolve
1987, chapter 33, the 4th and 6th resolve clauses, as amended by
26 Resolve 1989, c. 69, are further amended to read:

Report to the Legislature. Resolved: That the Department of the
Secretary of State present its report and revision of the Maine
30 Revised Statutes, Title 29, to the Joint Standing Committee on
Transportation and to the ~~First~~ Second Regular Session of the
32 115th Legislature on or before ~~January 1, 1991~~ November 1, 1992;
and be it further

Carrying clause. Resolved: That funds previously appropriated
36 for this purpose shall carry forward to fiscal year ~~1990-91~~
1991-92.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the
40 preamble, this resolve takes effect when approved.
