(AFTER DEADLINE)

Be it	enacted	by	the	Peo	ple ·	of the	State	of	Maine	as	follows:

12 MRSA §7369, sub-§10, ¶A, as repealed and replaced by PL 1989, c. 883, §15, is amended to read:

A. Allocations are required for Saturdays for the period of June 8th to August 31st. Allecations—are—required—for Sundays—on—the—Penobscot—River—for—the—period—of—June—8th—to August——31st—— If the department determines that the recreational use limit will be reached on Sundays on the Penobscot River or on other days, the department shall provide by rule for allocations that may not exceed the passenger limitation of section 7368—A, subsection 3.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill removes mandatory whitewater rafting allocations for Sundays on the Penobscot River and gives the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife authority to provide allocations by rule when demand requires. The allocations by rule may not, in any event, exceed the current limit of 80 passengers per day per outfitter.
