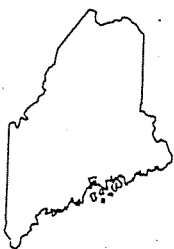

An Act Concerning the Bonding Authority of the Cumberland County
Recreation Center.

(AFTER DEADLINE)



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 P&SL 1971, c. 86, §2, last sentence, as amended by P&SL 1973, c.
4 225, is further amended to read:

6 The said district is further authorized and empowered to enter
into, and to perform under the terms of, contracts, agreements,
8 understandings and other commitments of every kind and
description necessary or convenient in connection with the
10 construction and operation of a multi-purpose recreation,
athletic and municipal center and ~~furthe~~ to borrow, mortgage and
12 pledge and issue bonds, notes or other obligations upon such
security as the trustees deem necessary or convenient ~~therewith~~;
14 except that an issue of bonds, notes or other obligations that
singly or in the aggregate with previous debts and liabilities
16 incurred after October 1, 1991 exceeds \$2,000,000 must be
approved in advance by the voters of Cumberland County in a
18 referendum vote.

22 STATEMENT OF FACT

24 This bill requires that the voters of Cumberland County
approve in a referendum vote any issue of bonds or other
26 obligations by the Cumberland County Recreation Center, also
known as the Cumberland County Civic Center, when that issue,
28 singly or in the aggregate with previous debts incurred after
October 1, 1991, exceeds \$2,000,000.
