HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 685, L.D. 1819, Bill, "An Act
Concerning Federal and Other Special Revenue Funds in Maine State
Government"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 7 and section
8.

Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read
consecutively.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The amendment deletes the parts of the bill that prohibit
employees of the Department of Human Services from soliciting
others to utilize services provided by the department for which a
fee is charged.
