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K. Establish a procedure to obtain assistance and advice from consumers of mental health services regarding the selection of contractors when requests for proposals are issued for mental health services.

Sec. 5. Phase in of process. Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 34-B, section 3604, subsection 3, paragraph E and section 6203, subsection 1, paragraph J, the Commissioner of Mental Health and Mental Retardation shall establish a schedule to ensure that, of the contracts subject to those provisions, 1/3 are subject to the request-for-proposal process in calendar year 1992, 1/3 in calendar year 1994 and 1/3 in calendar year 1996. 12

FISCAL NOTE

This bill requires the Department of Mental Health and 18 Mental Retardation to submit requests for proposals prior to awarding contracts for the purchase of mental health services for 20 children. associated with adults and The costs the request-for-proposal process, establishing a procedure for obtaining assistance and advice from mental health consumers and 22 the establishment of the required schedule will be absorbed 24 within the budgeted resources of the affected bureaus within the Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation.' 26

STATEMENT OF FACT

30 This amendment clarifies that contracts of \$150,000 per year or more that are awarded by the Department of Mental Health and 32 Mental Retardation for the purchase of mental health services for adults and children are subject to the request-for-proposal process every 6 years. The amendment removes a provision from 34 the bill that required contracts to be issued for 2-year 36 periods. The amendment also clarifies that the request-for-proposal process is to be phased in over the next 3 38 even-numbered calendar years.

The amendment adds a requirement that the Department of 40 Mental Health and Mental Retardation seek consumer advice in 42 awarding contracts. It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
