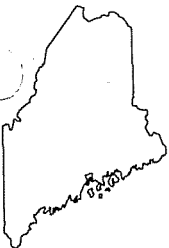

**An Act Concerning Room Requirements for Hotels under the Liquor
Licensing Laws.**



2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **28-A MRSA §1061, sub-§4, ¶A, as amended by PL 1989, c. 139,**
is further amended to read:

6 A. The number of rooms required is based on the population
8 of the municipality in which the hotel is located.

10 (1) If the hotel is located in a municipality of 3,000
or less population, the hotel must have at least ~~12~~ 6
adequate sleeping rooms.

12 (2) If the hotel is located in a municipality of more
14 than 3,000 but not more than 7,500 population, the
hotel must have at least ~~20~~ 10 adequate sleeping rooms.

16 (3) If the hotel is located in a municipality of 7,500
18 or more population, the hotel must have at least ~~30~~ 14
adequate sleeping rooms.
