An Act Concerning Room Requirements for Hotels under the Liquor Licensing Laws.

_	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	28-A MRSA §1061, sub-§4, ¶A, as amended by PL 1989, c. 139,
4	is further amended to read:
б	A. The number of rooms required is based on the population
8	of the municipality in which the hotel is located. (1) If the hotel is located in a municipality of 3,000
10	or less population, the hotel must have at least $\frac{12}{6}$ adequate sleeping rooms.
12	(2) If the hotel is located in a municipality of more
14	than 3,000 but not more than 7,500 population, the hotel must have at least 20 <u>10</u> adequate sleeping rooms.

	(3) If the hotel is located in a municipality of 7,500
18	or more population, the hotel must have at least 30 <u>14</u> adequate sleeping rooms.
