An Act to Allow Municipalities to Establish Fees for Copies of Vital Records.

(AFTER DEADLINE)



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

30-A MRSA §2652-A is enacted to read:

§2652-A. Alternative fee schedule

Notwithstanding section 2652, a municipality may annually set a fee schedule to establish fees for providing vital records or copies of vital records. The fees set and collected by the municipality may not exceed fees charged for similar records by the Department of Human Services under the authority of Title 22, section 9.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill allows municipalities to set fees for providing vital records so long as the fees do not exceed those charged by the Department of Human Services for similar records.
