HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1265, L.D. 1834, Bill, "An Act Creating the Victims' Compensation Board"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. 5 MRSA §12004-J, sub-§11 is enacted to read:

<u>11.</u>	<u>Victims'</u>	<u>Legislative</u>	<u>25 MRSA</u>
<u>Public</u>	<u>Compensation</u>	<u>Per Diem</u>	<u>\$3952'</u>
<u>Safety</u>	<u>Board</u>	<u>and Expenses</u>	

Further amend the amendment in section 5 in that part designated "§3951. in subsection 1 in the last line (page 3, line 10 in amendment) by striking out the following: "subsection 9." and inserting in its place the following: 'subsection 11.'

Further amend the amendment by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

This amendment is offered on behalf of the Committee on Bills in Second Reading. The amendment corrects an allocation to the Maine Revised Statutes and faulty section numbering.
